Dear colleagues,

In 2016, TU Wien, the Department for Urban Planning and Landscape Architecture, TU Wien and the Faculty of Architecture, Zagreb, went for a cooperation to co-analyze tourism topics of mutual interest. Both countries depend on an extraordinary high percentage on the income of tourism. Within TTL a co-operation was built up and Ana Mrđa is currently a post-doc and guest researcher at TU Wien. Fields of current and future co-operation will be marked and more colleagues are invited to contribute in the frame of this cooperation.

The "European toolkit for sustainable tourism destination" is under examination for its practical usability in Croatian and Austrian tourism destinations alike. In what way it fits and where we consider the need of additional parameters? 
